Who is Bryan Richmond?

This form replaced the C-4 form
in July of 2022

What is the CMS-1500 Form?

The form utilized to capture an injured employee's wages
earned during the 52 weeks prior to an injury

What is the C-240 form?

When a claimant remains totally disabled
in excess of the established healing period

What is protracted healing period?

This form offers an "x" designation for gender

What is the C-11 form?

An injured worker would use this form to request assistance

What is form RFA-IW?

The form used by an injured worker to request a re-determination because of an extreme hardship

What is Form C-35?

This form is used to notify providers of refusal to pay a medical bill due to issues like improper CPT codes

What is Form C8.4?

The year of the highest workers' compensation

maximum rate increase

What is 2011?

(the maximum weekly benefit rate increased from \$600 to \$739.83, a 23.3% increase)

What is form C-107?

The maximum number of days in which an award must be paid following a Memorandum of Board Panel Decision in order to avoid a late payment penalty

What is 10 calendar days

The number of days the employer/carrier has to respond to a PAR/non-formulary medication request, including medical marijuana

What is 4 calendar days?

The number of days a TPA has to commence lost time benefits
to an injured worker who is losing time from work following a compensable injury

What is 18 days

The C-2F form, otherwise known as the
Employer's Report of Work-Related
Injury/Illness form must be filed within this
many days after the occurrence

What is 10 days?

An RB-89 or Application for Board Review, must be filed within
this many days of the Law Judge's Decision

What is 30 days?

The guidelines developed by the Board that sets forth the recommended medical care in the treatment of work-related injuries and conditions.

What is MTG (Medical Treatment Guidelines)

A document filed by either an injured worker
or their legal representative or
by the employer/third-party
administrator prompting additional activity
from the Board.

What is RFA?

(Request for Further Action)

The law that provides the public right to access records maintained by government agencies, with certain exceptions.

FOIL

(What is Freedom of Information Law)

The form used to request the work history
for an injured worker to determine the
loss of wage-earning capacity

What is VDF

(Vocational Data Form)

A condition that must be met to
establish a work-related accidental injury.

What is ACOE

(Arising out of and in the Course of Employment)
